The demographic study suggests an immediate need for multiple land purchases in the next 1-5 years.

WHAT IS THE LAND TRUST?

The Land Trust was established in the late 1980's as a result of the sale of property to North Carolina State University. This infusion of capital allowed the Diocese of Raleigh to purchase parcels of land to establish new parishes. This foresight was fundamental in the expansion of the Diocese in conjunction with the rapid growth in The Triangle and beyond.

Today, we continue to experience significant growth with the Diocese of Raleigh being one of the fastest growing in the country. Since 2019, the Diocese has engaged in demographic research to determine growth patterns and future needs of Catholics in our Diocese. The results of that study are the catalyst for the next phase of land acquisition.
